DESCRIPTION:

Scholars have often drawn attention to the fact that in international development initiatives (funding schemes, projects, policy advice), social issues related to health, gender and migration have been often treated separately. This has been noticed in many regions of the world. Such compartmentalisation, however, does not reflect the messy and interlinked social reality. Currently, we see the emergence of more multi-faceted projects which take into the account these complex dynamics and needs of targeted populations. This roundtable aims to approach this issue with respect to Central Asia from scholarly and practitioner perspective, to tackle the following questions:

- When does compartmentalisation happen and when not? What does it depend on?
- What are the specific examples related to health, gender and migration when this is the case and when this is not the case?
- Who perpetuates these dynamics and who resists them?
- How do project designs change over time, as a result? And how do these changes influence the actual work on the ground on particularly burning issues, such as TB, HIV/AIDS, gender-based violence and migrants' access to healthcare?
- Which obstacles remain? What are lessons learned and the ways forward?

The roundtable gathers representatives of international organisations, non-governmental organisations, academia and think-tanks from Central Asian countries, Russia and France.

The roundtable participants have been asked to prepare a short opening statement (5 min) which will address some of the roundtable questions of their choice based on their experience and observations. These insights will create a basis for further discussion among the key speakers and with the audience.
